Students can further specialise or diversify their expertise by opting for one of the following majors:

FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT

International Accounting

Financial statements under IFRS and US GAAP, revenue recognition, accounting for financial instruments, lease accounting, derivatives, hedges and foreign currency financial statements.

Structured Finance

Structured finance products used in capital market funding by non-financial corporations: trade finance, export structured finance, asset finance; structures, risk-return features and valuation.

Process Management & Benchmarking

Introduction to process analysis; formalising and analysing processes, performance analysis and benchmarking.

FINANCIAL INTERMEDIATION

LBO & Private Equity

Private equity financing: leveraged buy-outs, other private equity financing techniques, valuation of private equity interests and strategies for value creation.

Project Finance

Long-term financing of capital investment projects based on projected cash flow. topics include principles, structuring of limited-recourse projects and risk-return characteristics.

Corporate & investment banking: a focus on equity capital markets by Société Générale

Equity capital markets, legal framework. Covers mid- and large-cap deals; equity-linked instruments.
